WELCOME TO WORSHIP

Thanks for joining us today! Whether you were raised in a home that regularly worshipped, only went to church on Christmas and Easter, or are exploring the Christian faith for the first time – we are glad you are here. If you haven't been to a Lutheran Church before, our worship format might be a unique experience for you. Our service is filled with symbolism and ancient tradition that propels our hearts *upward*. Today, we encourage you to embrace the *extraordinariness* of our *ordinary* worship, where God forgives our sins, the Holy Spirit prepares us for daily life, prayers are lifted, and heaven and earth converge. Sundays may seem ordinary, but they are also filled with extraordinary moments that we should not miss. If you have any questions, our staff, volunteers, and your fellow worshippers are here to answer any questions and help in any way they can.

THE SEASON OF EASTER

Easter, the pinnacle of the Christian liturgical calendar, follows the reflective season of Lent and culminates in the joyous celebration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The liturgical color for Easter is typically white or gold, symbolizing the triumph of light over darkness and the victory of life over death. As we enter into the Easter season, we are called to contemplate the significance of Christ's resurrection, and what it means to live as "Easter people."

CHILDREN IN WORSHIP

If you brought little ones with you today – we are overjoyed to have them here. While your worship might feel more like a wrestling match, a battle of wills, or a circus... your time, efforts, and distracted worship are worth it. Even the messiest and most frustrating days are not wasted. If your little one just needs a place to stretch their legs for a second, we have a staffed **Kid Care** for 0-2-year-olds on the second floor of the courtyard and a **Family Room** in the back of the sanctuary.

WHAT'S A "LUTHERAN"?

Simply put, Lutherans are *Christians.* We are catholic, but not Roman; orthodox, but not Eastern; evangelical, but not Baptist; reformed, but not Presbyterian. We hold to the *apostolic faith* (the faith of Jesus' apostles) and adhere to the principles of the Reformation, emphasizing Christ alone as the way to eternal life. We hold that the Bible is the inspired Word of God and has no error and that through God's Word and Sacraments (Holy Baptism, the Eucharist, and Absolution), we are forgiven, strengthened, and equipped to live as disciples. LIFE GROUP GUIDE | NEW LIFE TO THE WORLD | WEEK 1

- Share a moment from your life when you felt the presence of God's "light" or experienced His grace in a powerful way.
- Read 1 John 1:1—2:2.
- John says "if we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth" (v. 6). How do we walk in darkness?
- Where do you see darkness in our world today? What does it look like, as a Christian, to walk in the light in a world full of darkness?
- John says "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." This is an exhortation to confession. Martin Luther, in his 1529 writing A Brief Admonition to Confession, says "When I urge you to go to Confession, I am doing nothing else than urging you to be a Christian." What prevents you from confessing or admitting fault (to others, to your pastor, etc.)?
- When someone confesses/admits fault to you, is it easy for your to pronounce forgiveness?
- Where do you need the Holy Spirit's help to "walk in the light" right now in your daily life?
- End your time by sharing prayer requests.
