### 1. Mentoring is relational.

- Proverbs 22:6 ***Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old, they will not turn from it.***
- Titus 2:6-8 ***<sup>6</sup> Similarly, encourage the young men to be self-controlled. <sup>7</sup> In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show integrity, seriousness <sup>8</sup> and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us.***

### 2. Mentoring makes a difference.

- Proverbs 1:5 ***let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance—***
- Hebrews 13:7 ***Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith.***

### 3. Mentoring is Biblical.

- 2 Timothy 2:2 *And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.*
- Matthew 28:19-20 <sup>19</sup>*Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,* <sup>20</sup>*and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age.*
